



## INVITATION

### Latvia Indoor Open archery championship 2019

**1. Aim and exercises.** To find out winners of competition and national champions of Latvia, to improve personal best results and national records, to popularize archery as an Olympic sport.

**2. Rules.** Competition is open for everybody in individual and team competition, competition will be in WA defined bow divisions women and men separately, in two shooting groups. Qualification round will consist of 25m Round and 18m Round. Elimination round will be according to WA rules. All teams will shoot team elimination round, according to bow division. **Team members must be from one club, it is necessary to have the same uniforms.** Teams will be completed according to qualification results, or according to team managers application which is given to organisers no later than 10 minutes after qualification is completed. Organizers have rights to make international club teams from archers who don't have a team. According to WA rules winner of competition is found out through elimination rounds not qualifications.

**3. Place and time.** 15th – 17th February 2019. Ventspils Olympic center, gymnastic manage (Ventspils, Sporta street 7/9).

**4. Organizers.** Competition is organized by Latvian Archery Federation in collaboration with Council of Latvian sport federations, National Olympic Committee, Ventspils Olympic center un SK "Odisejs". Judging team will consist of 6 judges, they will be named at 1st day of competition.

#### **5. Programm of competition:**

##### **15.02.2019**

20:00-22:00 – official practice, registration, equipment inspection.

##### **16.02.2019**

##### **1st shooting group (R bow division)**

08:00 – 08:30 – registration, equipment inspection

08:30 – 11:30 – 4 warm-up ends, 25m round (triple target)

11:30 – 12:00 – break

12:00 – 15:00 – 1 warm-up end, 18m round (triple target)

15:00 – 15:15 – opening ceremony for both shooting groups (all bow divisions)

##### **2nd shooting group (all other bow divisions)**

14:30 – 15:00 – registration, equipment inspection

15:15 – 18:00 – 4 warm-up ends, 25m round (C bow triple target, other bows full target)

18:00 – 18:30 – break

18:30 – 21:30 – 1 warm-up end, 18m round (C bow triple targets, other bows full target)

**17.02.2019**

9:30 – 10:00 – warm-up (free to choose your index)

10:00 – 11:30 – team quarterfinals, semifinals, finals

11:30 – 14:30 – individual elimination round (starting from 1/16, 1 warm-up end when starting)

14:30 – 15:00 – break

15:00 – award ceremony

**6. Entry fees.** Entry fee is 20,00 EUR per each bow division. It can be paid through transfer: bank account - LV31HABA0551037808313; BIC/SWIFT code - HABALV22; bank – Swedbank; in additional information code **BACT19, your name, surname and bow division must be written (example – BACT19 Eduards Lapsins RM)**, or with a payment card 20,20 EUR.

**7. Registration.** Registration must be made through <https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLScgAZQu7-pJUprMubSZIhMzMkNJRF-atpGDEe93yiVfEPVd1g/viewform> till 10.02.2019. (inclusive). When the participant is registering for the competition, he/she should mark if he/she is ready to participate in the team competition and approves his/her health condition is satisfactory as well as the awareness of the competition rules (including WA official rules), safe shooting safety rules and the financial responsibility for intentional inventory spoiling. Competitors must know their club manager at competitions. Competition hall can take 200 competitors minus 1 for each disabled archer. Competition will be organized in two shooting groups.

**8. Awarding.** Winners of each bow division will get medal and diploma. Only archer who has affiliation to Latvia (with or without latvian nationality) can be champion of Latvia, so if there is no chances to find out national champion through elimination round, archer from Latvia who has the highest score in qualification round will be awarded as champion of Latvia. There is no title “champion of Latvia” for winners of team competition.

**9. Dresscode** – national, club, sports or white form and sport shoes (all foot covered). Athlete’s surname (on their back) must be visible from a distance.

**10. Participant agrees there will be publicly available results with participant names, surnames, names of member club, countries, categories in public space. Also photos and video can be published in competition official homepage. Organizers has rights to test competitors with alcometer.**

*Organizing committee has rights to change program (5.) depending on participant number and process of competition. Participant’s obligations is to keep up with published changes. Other changes (if they are needed) will be accepted in emergency team managers meeting with ascendancy of their votes. Organizing committee are allowed to make final decision in case of equal votes.*
